2024-2025 Tryouts

Our tryout process is a systematic experience designed to assess your athlete in her specific role based on the skills we believe necessary to assign her to a team that best fits her play style and abilities. Throughout the tryout, each player will have their opportunities to be evaluated by multiple coaches, multiple times.

Step 1: Register for Tryouts

- Tryout registration link can be found on our website (fusionvball.com)
- All Tryout Clinics and Tryouts will be held at Pioneer High School.

Step 2: Attend Tryout Clinics

The Tryout Clinics are designed for players to get contacts prior to tryouts and meet our Fusion staff. During the Tryout Clinics, coaches may make soft offers.

Step 3: Attend Tryouts

Players will be evaluated on their skills based on the positions they are trying out for. Teams will be finalized. Make up tryouts will be held November 2 if needed.

Step 4: Team Offers / Waitlist

Head Coaches will call families to make formal offers right after the tryout is concluded and will continue throughout the day of tryouts.

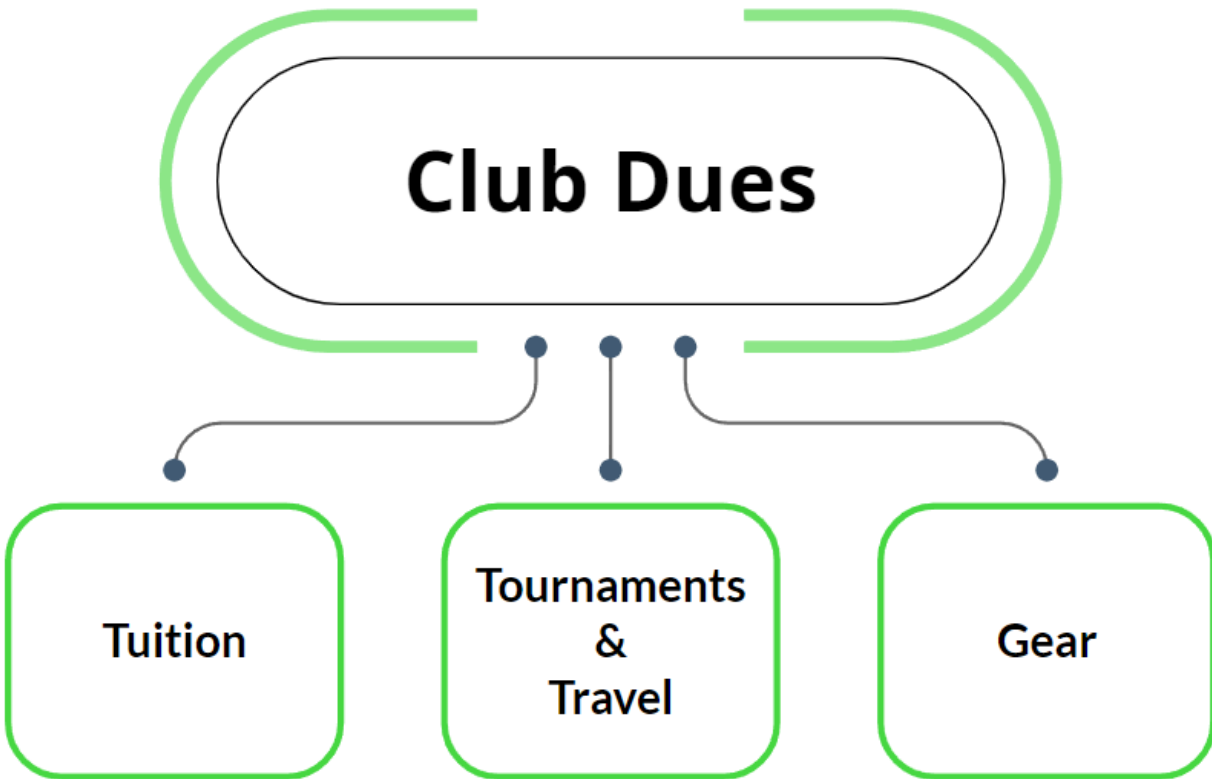
- Players will have 24 hours to make a decision.

Cost and Billing - New

The cost of the season will be divided into two main components. Tuition and Tournament/Travel Fees. Each is outlined below.



2024-2025 Season Tuition

Season tuition includes the general fixed cost of the club season. Coaching Salaries, Gym Rentals, Governing Body Team Registrations fees, General Club Operations, Equipment.

Billing

- Can be paid in full at signing (July 31, 2024, October 30, 2024)
- Billed in three even installments
 - Signing Day (July 31, 2024)
 - January 1, 2025
 - February 1, 2025

Tournament/Travel Fees - New

This year we have decided that the cost of the tournaments and the travel for coaches will be separated to allow for more accuracy and transparency. Included in the Tournament/Travel Fees are tournament entry fees, all coaches travel including airfare, hotel, ground transportation, and coaches per diem for all travel tournaments.

Families are responsible for the travel and lodging arrangements for themselves and their athletes. We believe this creates a safer and more appropriate environment for our families and athletes. There will be certain tournaments where there is a requirement to stay at certain hotels and room blocks. These are called "Stay to Play" and we will notify teams ahead of time regarding which tournaments these are and the timing of books. Fusion Volleyball will be going back to setting up room blocks for our families to use this season to aid in a better team dynamic and ease of planning.
